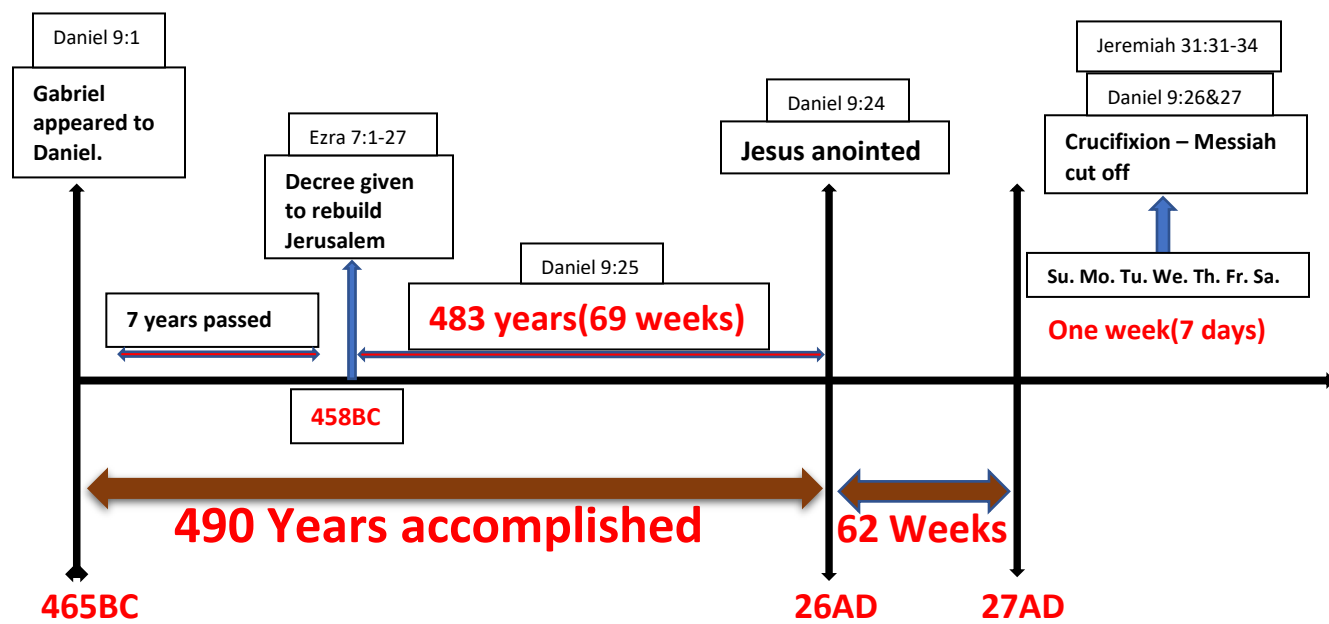


Daniel 70 weeks chart

This chart serves as an illustration of the correct interpretation of the Daniel 70 weeks prophecy and not to pin-point the actual dates the prophecies were fulfilled.



Additional Infromation

1. Dates used are approximate dates as there is no way to know the precise historical dates of the reign of the king Artaxerxes. The information is obtained from secular sources, and for me personally, my thoughts are that any information outside of the bible could be from the devil himself to cause doubts.
2. The Day for a principle should not be applied to all the time periods given. It should only be applied to the 70 weeks(490 years) and the 69 weeks(483).
3. The startint point for the **70 weeks(490 years)** should be calculated from the time that Gabriel appeared to Daniel. This is stated at the beginning of the chapter in verse 1. The first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus. This year is also the first year of King Artaxerxes. Darius was his brother and was killed after only a few months and then he became king in the same year.

4. The starting point for the **69 weeks(483 years)** is seven years later or in the 7th year of the reign of King Artaxerxes according to Ezra 7:7. This is the reason that there appears to be a gap of seven years, but there is no gap, the prophecy is immaculately accurate. It seems like for some reason almost everyone who reads this prophecy just have not been able to understand it correctly.
5. Messiah cut-off after **62 weeks**. What Gabriel said here is that after the Messiah would be annointed he would be crucified after 62 weeks. That is 1 year and 2 ½ months. I know it is the consensus among christians that Jesus earthly ministry was for 3 ½ years but the bible states that he was crucified after 62 weeks and there is no evidence in the bible against this. As christians it is incumbent upon us to believe the bible, the word of God, and not anything else.
6. Daniel 9:27 said he(the Messiah) shall confirm the covenant for **1 week**. This one week is 7 actual days and not 7 years. The covenant which Jesus confirmed was the covenant that God had promised to the Israelites for thousands of years. **Jeremiah 31:31-34**. And as with all the other feasts and festivals, God also set aside the week of Feast of Unleavened to be fulfilled in Jesus Christ. The middle of the week which Gabriel mentioned is the Wednesday on which Jesus was crucified, the veil of the temple being rented when he gave up the Ghost signifying the end of the need for sacrifices and oblations.
7. **THERE IS NO UNFULFILLED PORTION OF THIS PROPHECY. ALL THE TIME CONTINGENT MILESTONES GIVEN WERE FULFILLED IN JESUS, AND THEN THE DESTRUCTION OF THE TEMPLE.**
